3. Baltic Sea Festival in Eckernförde

In 2023 we warmly welcome you to the “Baltic Sea Festival”, the largest ocean sports festival in Germany, for the third time. The event will take place from 02.06. until 04.06.2023 in Schwedeneck, at the Grönwohld campsite and of course on the Baltic Sea. All boats that are seaworthy and can be moved with muscle power and paddles are eligible to participate. The races are open to paddlers of all nations.



We don't want to exclude anyone, so we will provide you with all the options for your paddling preferences. We try to improve this event with your wishes and suggestions. That's why we have some innovations at the start this year, with paddling of course being the main focus at all times. If you would like to know more about this year's cost calculation, please contact us and we can then present it transparently.

Our event location is on the well-designed and very family-friendly Grönwohld campsite. With townhouses, caravans and plenty of other pitches, it offers us the ideal opportunity to combine accommodation and sport. A fairground with a marquee, as well as exhibition areas for the expected exhibitors of SUP, surfski and outriggers are blocked and expect their audience to look and talk shop. It is also important to us that everyone can travel to this event as they wish, it is a worthwhile weekend especially for the whole family. In this way, the enthusiasm for paddling can be transferred to small, large, woman or man. So pack up your kith and kin and enjoy a great weekend with all your loved ones and friends.

Boat classes:

SUP, SUP Foil, Surfski 1ér and 2ér, Sea Kayak, OC1 and OC2, Vaá 1ér and Vaá 6ér

All boat classes can be driven as a female or male rating. In the twos and also in the sixes (at least 3 women) a mixed evaluation is possible.

An individual rating is only possible with at least five boats starting in the respective boat class/rating!

A junior race will be held separately in the registered boat classes, which will be evaluated separately and awarded high-quality prizes. The aim should be to give ocean sports a platform for young people and to guarantee the clubs a safe environment for sailing the Baltic Sea for the first time.

Tracks

The main race (Profitrack) will be held as a downwind over approx. 27 km on June 3rd, 2023. For juniors (15 - 18 years) and newcomers to the season there will be a shortened race over approx. 13 km (beginners' track).

Start 1: Eckernförde (South Beach) 24340 Eckernförde

Start 2: Eckernförde (south beach)

Goal 1: Diving site Kiel, Sportstrand, Am Deich 1, 24229 Strande

Destination 2: Grönwohld Camping (water sports beach)

Since the races are held as downwind races, the start and finish can be swapped due to the wind direction.




Option: If you register for the 13km route because you are unsure whether you are in good shape, you can register and de-register when you reach the short goal in order to be counted in the long route as well.

Course

- The route goes from the southern beach along the warning area in the direction of the Kiel lighthouse to the Strande sports beach. On the way, the race for the newcomers to the season ends at the Grönwohld campsite
- The route always runs along the coast.
- The Surendorf restricted area must be bypassed on the sea side.
- Before Dänisch - Nienhof, turn off at the marshalling post in the direction of the Bülk lighthouse (checkpoint).
- The Bülk lighthouse will be bypassed.

This routing applies to south-west to north winds. When the wind is from north to southeast, the route is run in the opposite direction.

Schedule (tentative)

Friday 06/02/2023

- Arrival (if you want to, of course, talk to the campsite)
- 3:00 p.m. First common downwind 12 km
- Boat testing at Grönwohld Camping site
- Booking option for Downwind Clinic (must be agreed with the cracks in advance)
- Joint evening and exchange of experiences according to your own needs on the fairground
- Registration for Saturday until 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m

Saturday 06/03/2023

- 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.: Registration at the Grönwohld festival site
- 10:30 - 10:50 am: Race briefing for all participants (compulsory participation) at the Grönwohld festival site in German and English
- 9:00 - 11:30 am Loading the boats onto the shuttle trailer
- 11:30 am: Departure to the start
- 12:00 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.: Unloading, moving vehicles, preparation for take-off
- From 1:00 p.m. check at the starting point
- 1:30 p.m. Start of the 3rd Baltic Sea Race
- Depending on the number of entries, the junior race will be started separately
- from 4:00 p.m.: finish (the last person should have made it by 6:00 p.m.)
- 8:00 p.m. award ceremony and cozy conclusion (from 7 p.m. catering in buffet form, which is also suitable for vegetarians, is included in the entry fee! The beer wagon on the festival meadow can be used by self-purchase and is ready for you.)

The organizer reserves the right to cancel or reschedule the race at short notice in the event of bad weather. In the case of weather conditions that make the race impossible, the organizer cannot assume any liability and, from an organizational point of view, unfortunately cannot refund the entry fee.

Sunday 06/04/2023

- 10:00 a.m. common downwind
- depending on wind conditions between 12 and 18 km
- the route will be announced the evening before
- please be at the starting point in good time

All routes driven are discussed in advance by the organizers and their surfing and ocean professionals and all participants are informed in a briefing. The goal will always be to be able to welcome all paddlers back to the finish line in good health, and the DLRG will also do everything for that.

Transport:

- Basically, a shuttle service for boats is offered.
- The boats can be shuttled on the provided trailers for a fee of €5.00. Pre-registration is mandatory!
- Bring your own fastening material and do the loading yourself to avoid damage in transit.
- Once the places have been allocated, the participants should help each other, just like at any other event.
- New: This year we want to set up a bus shuttle between start - campsite - finish to make it easier to transport people on the day of the race, so that every participant has the chance to return to the base quickly after their race
- the buses will run every 20 minutes

Security

- The races will be held on the open Baltic Sea. Every participant is aware of the resulting dangers. Each participant starts at their own risk. The organizer assumes no liability for personal injury and/or damage to property.
- Participants who have not yet reached the age of 18 require parental consent, which must be submitted with the registration.
- Each participant is obliged to help participants in need.
- Cell phone coverage on the track for feedback to the race director is 100%. The communication between the race management, the support vehicles (water and land) and the participants takes place via the mobile network.
- At least 8 lifeboats will accompany the race. One boat will be the lead boat along with the first. A second boat will form the end of the field as a "finishing boat". The other boats will regularly oscillate between leading and trailing. The escort boats can pick up participants in need and bring them directly to shore. From there they will be taken over by an escort vehicle. The rescue of participants in distress has priority over securing the material.
- **New:** Every boatman is responsible for his line management, whoever comes from behind has to pay attention to the one in front of him and to overtake him safely.
- Participants who have not passed Däniskenhagen (16 km) at 4:00 p.m. will be taken out of the race for safety reasons
- Participants who clearly miss the finish time of 6:00 p.m. will be taken out of the race by the finishing boat.
- Participants who have decided on the professional track when registering and leave the beginner track for personal reasons will have this time officially noted, but are considered DNF (did not finish).
- **New:** Waypoints are marked by separate orange buoys measuring 90 cm x 150 cm

- All route points explained in the race briefing must be circumvented. In the event of a clear violation, the participant will be rated DNQ (Disqualified) or receive a time penalty of at least 10 minutes. These points also count as control points!
- In windless conditions, the routes are driven on a circular course, which is intended to prevent any overloading. It also represents an ecologically sensible alternative to avoid unnecessary shuttles in this case.

Safety equipment for all participants (MANDATORY)

- Each participant must wear a CE certified life jacket with a minimum buoyancy of 50N.
- **IN the SUP area - Restube** can be used as an alternative, but must be proven on request and have a minimum buoyancy of 50 N. ATTENTION, DLRG and organizers point out that a life jacket is the safe alternative!
- Each participant carries a mobile phone that can also be used in the water at all times.
- The number is to be deposited with the race management when registering.
- At least one person per boat must be connected to the boat with a leash.
- A spare paddle is recommended in race classes OC1, OC2, Vaá 1ér and 6ér.
- Each participant has to choose his clothes according to the weather and water conditions. We assume a water temperature between 10 - 15 degrees.
- **Anyone who does not comply with the safety regulations will be automatically disqualified! A violation of the safety check at the start will result in exclusion from the race. Also a security breach, noted on the Water or in the target leads to it.**

Entry fee

Every starter receives a welcome bag when registering on site. In this you will find your start number, event goody, a buffet voucher for Saturday and small surprises. A very good protection on the water by the DLRG is guaranteed. The time is taken by an external company (Tollense - timing), which will measure the time using a chip and magnetic mat. The passenger shuttle with the buses is also included.

The event t-shirt can also be purchased this year. The costs are around €15.00 – €20.00. A T-shirt production only starts from 100 interested parties. A meaningful / special present awaits you in your goody bag.

- €90.00 per person for all starters except Vaá 6ér
- Vaá 6ér per boat €400.00
- €40.00 for juniors up to and including 18 years of age

The new timekeeping also makes registration more professional. The entry fees will be collected by the company Tollense-timing. This also results in a registration list that is always up-to-date.

Registration opening: 01/01/2023

Registration deadline: 03/31/2023

- If the starting places are not occupied by March 31th, 2023, you can register until April 30th, 2023. During this period the entry fee increases to €110.00, for the Vaá 6ér to €420.00
- late registration on site increases the entry fee to €130.00; for the Vaá 6ér to €440.00

If there are more than 300 boats, they will be placed on a waiting list. You will be moved up according to the receipt of the message. Successors will be informed by the organizer at short notice.

Accomodation

Accommodation options at Grönwohld Camping, please inquire by email. The reservation of the holiday homes, townhouses (of various sizes), caravans, glamping tents and sleeping cubes must be made by the participants themselves by specifying the event (Baltic Sea Festival). If you want to come by car, bus, mobile home or caravan, you will also be provided with the space you need. Here, too, you register with the operators for your own needs and then let yourself be comfortably instructed.
